Council Minutes

Tim Young called the meeting to order.

Those present were Fr. Ken Klink, Tim Young, Teresa Pelton, Joe Donlin, Lori Stadelman, Don Sparby, Rob Yeiser and Ann Legris. Guest, Ben Hofmeister.

Fr. Klink led us in prayer.

Minutes from previous meeting reviewed. Rob Yeiser motion to approve, Teresa Pelton 2nd. Minutes approved for April 4, 2010 meeting.

Fr. Klink indicated to council that the local Post Messenger Recorder newspaper is going to start charging for the church to place an ad. They will be charging a \$1.00 a line. Website - Ann Legris stated the need to have parish council members names, pictures and phones numbers on the website. Council agreed. Will have Joe Donlin take pictures on existing members so website can be updated with this information.

Don Sparby stated UW provisions has the best price for brats & hot dogs. He was quoted a price of \$1.49 per lb. for pre-cooked brats, \$1.39 per lb. for hot dogs and \$1.29 per lb. for all beef hot dogs. Council agreed to purchase meats from UW Provisions.

Don Sparby will contact Ginna Schenk in regards to how much Barbeque she made for the Bingo Bash. Don will also ask Renee Funseth about using the nesco roasters for the anniversary picnic.

Other items that will be needed are ketchup, mustard, onions & pickle relish.

Teresa Pelton suggested having someone do a video presentation of the history of St. Mary's and to tape during the Anniversary 11:00 am mass of members how may share their memories of St. Marys. KK stated Jerry Remy would be good to get information about the history, Brian Lamboley for possibly narrating and Dave Edge is knowledgeable in videos.
