| Summer, 2001 | - establishment of planning committee |
| Fall, 2001 | - comprehensive study of demographics, membership, financial status, space needs, existing facilities conducted |
| Winter, 2001-02 | - working subcommittees established
- property deeded to St. Mary's |
| Spring, 2002 | - Diocese approval of planning process
- initial report to parishioners at all weekend Masses |
| Summer, 2002 | - architect selection process finalized and initiated |
| Fall, 2002 | - architect and liturgical consultant chosen |
| Winter, 2002-03 | - involvement of planning committee and parish members in development of feasibility study and schematic plans |
| Spring, 2003 | - final consensus for building plans |
| Summer, 2003 | - planning of fundraising campaign |
| Fall, 2003 | - initiate fundraising (diocese guideline requires ½ of funding to be raised before building starts) |
| Summer, 2004 | - based on goal of successfully generating ½ of funding, develop final architectural plans |
| Winter, 2004-05 | - final approval of building plans, permit acquisition |
| Spring, 2005 | - begin construction |
| By Christmas, 2005 | - move into our new church! |
